Maths

We have continued to learn how to subtract through subtraction stories. The new learning has been around understanding that addition and subtraction are linked. For example, $10-3=7$, $10-7=3$ and $7+3=10$. The children have been challenged to show this pictorially and explain in mathematical language, what they have represented.
