

### **Parent Information Meetings**

#### Parent Evenings - Year 1-6

In the most recent parent survey, a number of you outlined that you liked the efficiency of online parents' evenings but you missed not being in the school and having time to see your child's classroom and the learning in their books. So, to address this, we have factored in both. The week we return from the half term break (w/b 31st October) we will be scheduling in open classroom sessions for Year 1-6 from 9-9:30am. This will be an opportunity for children to show you their classroom and their books, as well as a classroom activity. This is being done prior to parents' evening meetings, giving you a picture of your child within their learning environment which will hopefully support the conversation at the meeting. We will send out a letter next week outlining the timings for each year group, giving lots of time for you to plan.

## Parent Evenings - Nursery & Reception

Nursery and Reception parent meetings will be throughout the year and will be held on the week your child is a focus, you will be informed when this is, the week before. A staff member from your class will arrange a time to meet with you to discuss their indepth observations, progress and next steps at the end of their focus week. Nursery and Reception will also be offering open classroom sessions; the dates of these will be shared in the Nursery and Reception newsletters shortly.

## Tightening our Safeguarding Practices

From Monday we are asking parents to inform us of both <u>absence</u> and <u>changes to end of the day arrangements</u> using a dedicated email address (<u>attendance@kilmorie.lewisham.sch.uk</u>) The info@ mailbox gets very full and sometimes messages get lost. In order that we are able to get messages to teachers, <u>any changes</u> to end of day arrangements need to be <u>emailed before 3pm</u> and after that, only emergency changes should be made via a phone call.

The flow of traffic into the school in the morning is slow and steady and to support us to monitor unsupervised children, we will only be opening the main gates (the black fire gate will remain closed) in the mornings. We will however, continue to open both gates at the end of the day. To remind, no parent should be waiting in the playground prior to the gates opening at the end of the day as lessons are going on. Thank you for your continued support with keeping our children safe.

#### **School Dinners**

The cost of a primary school meal is £2.30 per day unless your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 in which case they will be entitled to the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) scheme or they are entitled to free school meals.

School dinners need to be paid for in advance, either weekly, monthly or half termly. Payments should be made via <u>Parentpay</u>. You will need to get Parentpay login details from the office if you do not already have them.


