**Re: Year 3 Educational Visit to the Horniman Museum**

Dear Parents and Carers,

To support our class with our Stone Age topic we have organised an Educational Visit to the Horniman museum **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March for Maria & Simone's class and Jo's class, and Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> March for Elis' class**. The children will become archaeologists, handle artefacts from the Stone and Bronze Ages and use them to work out the differences between life in the Palaeolithic and Neolithic. They will hold a 300,000 year-old hand axe, examine a real mammoth tooth, and learn about flint knapping.

We will be travelling by bus, **Maria and Jo's classes** will be leaving school promptly at **9.20am** and arriving back at approximately **2.30pm**. **Elis's class** will be leaving promptly at **10am** and arriving back at approximately **3pm**.

The cost of the trip will be £2.90 (£1.45 for children entitled to pupil premium).

We will need parent helpers for this trip. If you are able to travel with your child's class let us know using the link below on or before 16/02/2023. All volunteers will be informed in advance of the trip.

Your child will need a packed lunch for this trip. You can order one using the link below on or before 16/02/2023

For the trip, please ensure your child has the following:

- Comfortable walking shoes
- Sensible clothing appropriate to the weather
- Any medical requirements e.g. asthma inhalers, eczema creams, etc.
- A nut free packed lunch (in a small rucksack) unless you prefer to order a school packed lunch
- At least 2 drinks - one of which should be a refillable water bottle
