#### This week we have been:

- \*We designed and made a friend for Beegu by recycling materials and reusing what we have

### **Phonics**

In phonics we have been learning a new game that explores different spellings of same sounds, 'Where in the word is the phoneme? Beginning, middle or end' such as:

/oo//yoo/: unicorn, blue music

/ee/: happy bodies belief

/s//z/: face success visit tease

/oa/: yellow follow snow coat home total

We have also been learning to revisiting the tricky words: water / want / any / many /could / would / should / who / whole / where / ask / Mr / Mrs / Ms / school / call / people / your / their / thought / through / friend / again / two / work / different.
