 - Can you turn this repeated addition calculation into a multiplication one?



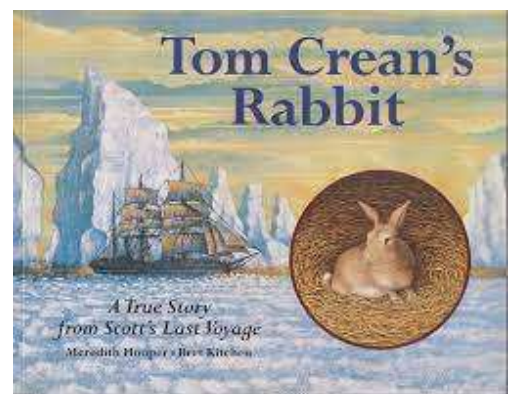
$$4 + 4 + 4 =$$
