This week we have been:

- * Describing the differences between old and new toys
- * Beginning to sew our own teddy bears.
- * Learning about the second pillar of Islam 'Salah', five daily prayers at dawn, noon, mid-afternoon, sunset and evening.
- * Learning how to become fit through pirate fitness
- * Teaching measuring skills and learning to measure objects with cubes to find their length, then investigating how to record this.

For home learning...

- * Measure objects around your home to see how long they are. As a challenge can you put them in order and calculate how many Lego bricks difference there is between them.

Phonics

In Phonics we have been learning the digraphs for: /or/a/ as in water /o/a/ as in want. Grow the code: /air/, as in bear and there.

We have also been practising the tricky words: who, whole, because, eye, people, thought and through.
