This term, we are continuing to learn about Antarctica and the explorers who have visited it. We have organised a trip to the National Maritime Museum so that the children can have an opportunity to consolidate their learning and explore a real ship.

All three classes will be going on Thursday, 23rd March.

We will be leaving school at 9:00 am and catching the 185 to Lewisham Station. From there, we will take the DLR to Cutty Sark. When we arrive at the museum, we will have self-guided tours of the Cutty Sark and explore the National Maritime Museum. We will be returning to school by the end of the school day.

Your child will need a packed lunch from this trip, and we will also need parent helpers. You can order a packed lunch using the link below on or before 15/03/2023

The cost of the trip will be £3.30 (£1.65 for PP children) which will be added to your ParentPay account shortly.

- sensible clothing appropriate to the weather
- a packed lunch unless you have ordered one in advance from the school
- any medical requirements e.g. asthma inhalers
- at least 1 drink - one of which should be a refillable water bottle
