### Week 1 - 17.03.23



#### This week we have been:

- \* Describing the differences between old and new toys specifically looking at different materials that they are made of.
- \* Continuing to sew our own teddy bears and add embellishments and features.
- \* Learning to sort objects by length and exploring ways to record this.

#### For home learning...

- \* You could read the story of Traction Man to your child and talk about the main character. Could you think of 5 adjectives (describing words) and make them into labels around a drawing of your character which you could then bring to show at school?
- \* Can you think of a toy that would have been made before Traction Man (2005) and after Traction Man? As a challenge, can you guess, very approximately, how many years before and after, your toy suggestions were made?
- \* Mini Grey is the author and illustrator- How do you think she got her name?  
(Ask Philippa if you want to know and can't find out yourself)
- \* Talk about the basics of Christianity in preparation for our visit to the local church
- \* Do something kind for the special carer in your home for Mothers' Day.

### Phonics

In Phonics we have been learning the phonemes for: ur/ ear learn, r/ wr wrist and grow the code: s/ whistle, science.

Continuing our learning about schwa, we have now added to our understanding and learnt that the unstressed phoneme (schwa) can come at the end of words as in 'actor' as well as in the middle (as in 'different').

We have also been practising the tricky words: many, any, friend, through, two and your.
