Cutting through the Early Years outdoor space to the main playground:

At the morning drop off you may cut through to drop off older siblings however you are not able to do this at the afternoon pick up. There is no access in the afternoon due to lessons still taking place on the main playground and the main gate still being closed. However the alleyway alongside the school will be open for you to use. If another person picks up your child e.g. child-minder or grandparent, please let them know of these new rules. Thank you for your understanding.



Every Friday morning from 8.45am – 9.30am, we will be holding a 'stay and play' session for parents and carers. To give the children sufficient time to settle in, our first session will be on **Friday 7th October**. We hope you can make it!
