Re: Year 6 Educational Visit to the Migration Museum

Dear Parents and Carers,

To support our children with their history learning around Black Britain (Windrush and beyond), we have organised an Educational Visit to the Migration Museum on 18th May (Nora and Dominic's classes) and 25th May (Jo's class). The children will learn about how the movement of people to and from the UK across the ages has made us who we are today – as individuals, as communities and as a nation. The visit will highlight the children's own connections to migration and foster understanding of various migrant experiences and stories.

We will be travelling by bus, leaving school promptly at 9.30am and arriving back at approximately 2.30pm.

The cost of the visit will be £3.70 (£1.85 for children entitled to pupil premium).

We will need parent helpers for this visit. If you are able to travel with your child's class let us know using the link below on or before 02/05/23. All volunteers will be informed in advance of the visit.

Your child will need a packed lunch for this visit. You can order one using the link below on or before 02/05/23

For the visit, please ensure your child has the following:

- Comfortable walking shoes
- Sensible clothing appropriate to the weather
- Any medical requirements e.g. asthma inhalers, eczema creams, etc.
- A nut free packed lunch (in a small rucksack) unless you prefer to order a school packed lunch
- At least 2 drinks - one of which should be a refillable water bottle
