Music and Movement

Last week, the children enjoyed their first session with our music teacher, Emily. Music is a fundamental element of learning in early years. Amongst many things, it helps the body and mind work together, strengthens memory skills and helps children to learn the sounds and meanings of words, as well as developing their sense of rhythm. By following instructions and mirroring actions, the children are also developing their listening and physical motor skills. And let's not forget the simple pleasures of self-expression through music and movement! The benefits are endless!
