This week we have been:

- *Our focus story is Snail and the Whale. We have been identifying human and physical features from the story.
- * Maths -We have been learning about Place Value. We have explored numbers up to 50.
- *PE - we are beginning to develop our agility, co-ordination and team building skills through Athletics and Multi skills in preparation for Sports Day.

For home learning...

- *Practise Simon Says (we are learning to label basic parts of the Human Body).

Phonics Revision - ay, a-e, ea, ee (he)

- *Can you practise reading the following sentence with expression - "May we play with you?" said the children.
 - *Talk about the speech marks and question mark with your children.
- Tricky words - eye, sure, pure, said and were.

*Remember to read with your child every day, not only decoding but also thinking about new vocabulary and thinking of alternative words that have the same (or even opposite) meanings.
