



Year One Home Learning

Week 1 - 28.04.23

This week:

- *Literacy-Our focus story is Snail and the Whale. We have been learning to use descriptive language through looking at the setting and characters in the story and writing a postcard to a friend from our imaginary visit to the locations in the story.
- * Maths -We have been learning to count in 2s and representing groupings pictorially and exploring using practical resources.
- * Science- We tried different foods and thought about which type of flavour they are, such as sour, bitter, sweet. We recapped our knowledge of senses.

For home learning...

- *Maths - practise counting orally in twos to 20, 50. Try matching the socks in pairs when you help with the washing. Count how many pairs you have. Challenge: How many single socks would that be?
- * Talk about your holidays/weekend and describe the setting e.g) the cold, pebbly beach, the rustling leaves in the expansive park.
- *Practise Simon Says (we are learning to label basic and less familiar parts of the Human body).

Phonics Revision - GPC ie/igh,(pie, high) i-e,(time) oa/o,(goat,) oe/o-e (note)

Tricky words – were, one, says, here, today

*Remember to read with your child every day and talk about the books and skills your child can use when they find it difficult to decode a word.
