Next half term we will continue to learn about tropical rainforests, and we will focus on the animals that live within them. We have organised a trip to the Horniman Museum to participate in a workshop, 'Animals and their Habitats' and to explore the grounds, looking at some of the tropical plants that grow there.

Sarah's Class will be visiting on the Tuesday 6th June. Kate and Shona's classes will be visiting on Thursday 15th June.

We will be leaving school at 9:30 am and catching the 185 to the Museum. We will be returning to school by the end of the school day.

- any medical requirements e.g. asthma inhalers
- at least 1 drink - one of which should be a refillable water bottle
