It's been a short week, but, busy as ever. The children enjoyed helping us get ready for the garden party by decorating our hand-made bunting. They have also been creating their own small worlds using recycled materials including a garden and fish tank! For all those royalists, the children have been making crowns and flags for the Coronation on Saturday. Many of them are very excited! Fiona has been wearing her own inflatable gold crown around the Nursery. The children have also been learning about the number 2 and exploring the ways we can make the number with different objects, such as our thumbs and fingers!

The children are making the most of the warmer weather and are spending much of their time outside. The sand pit is extremely popular, and the children are really working hard to take turns. In music they continue to learn about creatures under the sea and their imagination to turn the nursery into a colourful aquarium!

This week we have revisited 'The Colour Monster' and the Zones of Regulation. For those who are new to nursery, Kilmorie uses the 'Zones of Regulation' to help children express, understand and manage their feelings. In nursery we use three zones, red (cross, upset) green (calm, happy) and blue (sad, tired). This week we have introduced three pots, one for each zone. The children can place a wooden spoon into one of the pots to show how they are feeling at any one time. The children then move them throughout the day, depending on how they are feeling. This is a great way to start conversations about our emotions.
