Next Week

Full Days

We will start to send books home this coming week on your child's book bag day. Although we will be starting our new phonics programme Little Wandle next week, the 'reading' book we will be sending home will have no words. This is because there is value in 'reading' the pictures and telling a made-up story to promote confidence.

Your child may mention having some individual time out with an adult over the next three weeks. This is to get to know them better and give them an opportunity to share their knowledge with us.

We expect your children to be really tired and they may show some regression in their emotional regulation. We therefore advise that you don't start anything new for the next few weeks.

Hot Lunches

We will continue to let the children know in advance what is available for lunch and very soon the menus will be available for you to view on the website. As always, we will help the children to make choices and ensure restricted diets are adhered to.

Packed Lunches

Please remember that not only are we a sugar smart school, the children's lunches need to reflect this. We would recommend a savoury main, a piece of fruit and yogurt or other **<u>nut free</u>** cereal bar, as examples.

Morning drop-off

Please ensure that you come in through the Early Years gate (Elsinore Road) and bring your child right to the door of their classroom.

Naming clothes

This is very important if you'd like us to be able to return the clothes to you when you children become separated from them!

<u>Scooter park</u>

We no longer have a scooter park by the Early Years entrance. Please take any scooters or bikes to the main playground and park them in the bike shelter or alternatively, take them home.

Road closure at drop off and collection

Please do not let your children play in the road or around the parked cars. Although the road is closed to the general public, local residents can still use it for access along with bikes and motorbikes.
