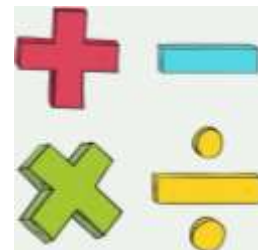

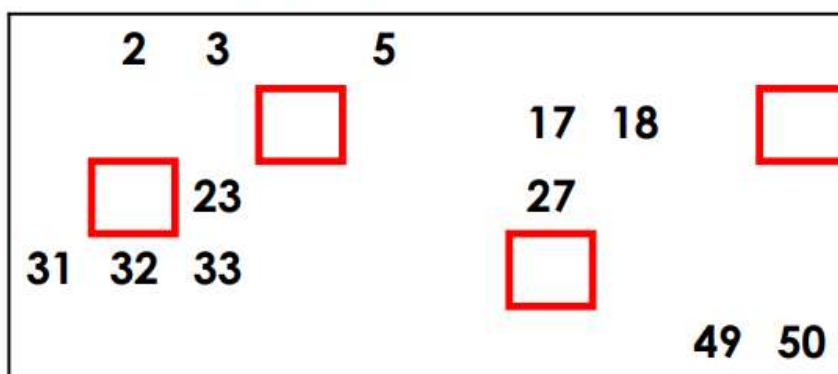


This week...

How many different ways can you use to find the answers? Try drawing dienes, using number lines, and making bar models.

$5 \times 5 = \underline{\quad}$
