Phonics

In phonics this week we have been learning these sounds: 'eigh' in eight, 'aigh' I straight 'kn' in knee, 'gn' in gnaw, 'mb' at the end of thumb, 'ere' in here and 'eer' in deer.

We have also been looking at 'fake' words and revising the tricky words:
