The scales balance.



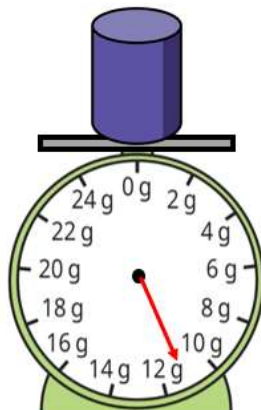
Explain why.

You will need to reorder the instructions below in the correct order.

- *Next, slice the banana, kiwi and strawberry.*
- *First, wash the fruit.*
- *Get a knife and a chopping board.*
- *Finally eat the delicious fruit kebab.*
- *Then, carefully slide all of the fruit pieces onto the skewer.*

The instructions need to be put into the right order so that someone can understand them easily.
