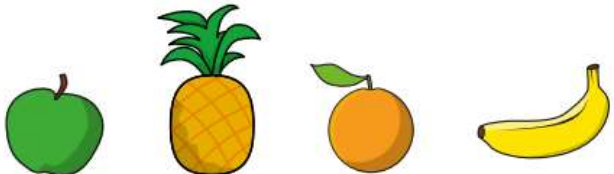


Year Two Home Learning

- We have been revisiting different topics in maths, using reasoning and problem-solving skills to answer questions.

 28p 43p 41p ? The total cost of an apple and a pineapple is the same as the total cost of an orange and a banana. How much does a banana cost?	$3 + \underline{\quad} + 7 = 19$ $\underline{\quad} + 4 + 6 = 11$ $2 + 6 + \underline{\quad} = 16$ $1 + \underline{\quad} + 3 = 13$
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- In English, we been creating packaging for our DT products. We thought about the appearance and function to make it suitable. Then we made sure that the packaging was eye-catching so that it would attract people.
