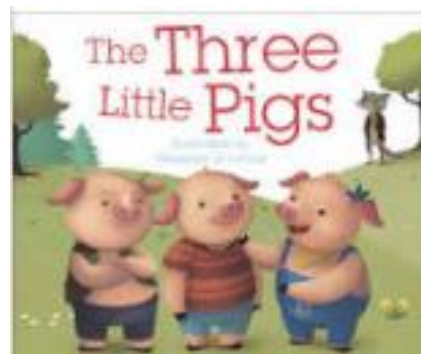


Year One Home Learning

This week we have been ...

- * Retelling the story of the Three Little Pigs, using story maps.

- * Discussing our feelings and relating them to the zones of regulation.
- * Using basic geographical language to describe the physical and human features of the school on an aerial map.
