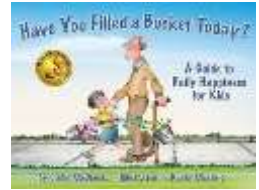


Weekly Learning Letter

Year 1 Home Learning

Well done to all the children! They have made a fantastic start to year 1 and have really settled well into their new classes.

This term our theme is Traditional Tales. We will be listening to and retelling the story of 'The 3 Little Pigs' through role play and story mapping and creating houses for the 3 little pigs using a range of different materials. We will also be learning about the story 'Handa's Surprise', making fruit baskets, creating simple maps of Handa's journey.

This week in year 1:

Getting to know the rules and routines in Year 1.

Familiarising ourselves with the [Zones of Regulation](#).

Counting forwards and backwards from 1-10 and playing number games.

The story 'Have You filled you Bucket?' and thinking about ways that we can show happiness and kindness to others.

Home learning ideas:

For home learning, you can...

- * Write or draw some ways that you can show kindness and happiness at home so that you can be a 'bucket filler'!
- * Find and count different objects around the house/garden/park.
- * Learn a number rhyme and make up actions/props to go along with it.

We have been reading with the children individually. Please remember to bring your book bag in every day. Please also continue to read with your child daily and encourage them to select a book to take home from our book areas.
