### Pick up Times

The pick-up times for each session are as follows:

### Clothing

- **Spare clothes** - please can you ensure your child has at least one set of spare clothes (named and in a bag) for toileting reasons, but also just in case they get wet due to the water play.
- **Wet weather** - as the weather is starting to become unpredictable, please make sure your child has a waterproof coat and wellies.
- **Shoes** – can we ask the children do not wear Crocs, as they are not suitable for activities in the outside area. Also, we would like to ask children wear shoes which promote their independence, such as Velcro or slip on shoes. Thank you!
