






## **Appreciations**

- We feel that the approach we took of allocating certain stalls to the teachers worked really well and hopefully we can continue doing this.




#### **Overview of financial performance**





#### Amount raised from fundraising and donations in 2022/23\*




Total Amount Raised £29,896

#### Proposed New Model Constitution


- FOK's current constitution is the PTA-UK Model Constitution dated Nov 2011, which was formally adopted without change at the AGM on 16th October 2014
- PTA-UK became Parentkind in February 2018 and is now the largest membership body for PTAs and other parent groups in England, Wales and Northern Ireland
- FOK is now proposing to adopt the Parentkind Model Constitution for England and Wales dated March 2021 without change
- FOK is a registered charity and the Parentkind 2021 Model Constitution is pre-approved by the Charity Commission for England and Wales
- The new constitution must be adopted at the AGM by a two-thirds majority of the votes cast

#### Comparison of the 2011 and 2021 Model Constitutions

- No change to i) the charitable purpose; ii) charitable status; or iii) the clause related to the use of property and funds except for the renaming of Clause 2 'Objects' as 'Purposes' so prior written consent not required from the Charity Commission
- New constitution permits General Meetings (AGMs and EGMs) and Committee meetings to be held physically or virtually by suitable electronic means, provided each participant can see and hear all other participants and the same rules apply as for physical meetings (e.g. chairing, taking of minutes and quorum)
- New constitution adds one additional power to the existing list to consult parents on their views
- New constitution requires a written opinion from a medical professional before a committee member ceases to be a member based on physical or mental incapacity
- New constitution makes clearer that an EGM can be called by 10 or more members, as well as by the committee itself

### 2023/24 Financial Plans

Fundraising target for 2023/24 £25,000





### Funding approvals - total estimated spend £7,000

The Committee are asked to consider and approve the following funding requests:

- 1. Up to £500 to the school garden to be drawn down over the year (similar to last year)
- 2. Teacher allocation of £3,750 this is £500 per year group plus £250 for nursery. Higher than what we gave last year (£2,300) which was £100 per class
- Continuation of our support of the Community library money raised from book sales to be used to purchase books. FoK general funds will cover running costs (around £250 for 2022/23)
- 4. Up to £3,000 from big half to be allocated to the school for projects agreed by the staff running the race, with the rest allocated to FoK general funds

### **Other Funding Priorities**

White Boards	FoK normally cover cost of whiteboards needing replaced each year. Previous cost of £3.5k each. Waiting confirmation of any needed this year
Trip allowance	Historically have donated £150 per class plus the EYGP funds. Propose some allocation this year, but pending discussion with Benita on how this should be structured
EY project	Decision yet to be taken on the beach trip. However, proposal is that the money from the EYGP will be donated to the EY team who will be responsible for deciding how it is spent.
Playground stage flooring	In urgent need of fixing. Quotes being obtained, however for info Susan's circle cost was £2,200 approx. To be done in this term.
Fence Art	An art project for everyone to get involved in across the school. Alligns with parent feedback that they would like to see more art projects across the school. Money would be used to engage a consultant to get the project off the ground.
Community room	Design of the community room to make it a multi functional and welcoming community hub for the school. It will incorporate and support the community library.
Playground astroturf	Floor is in need of repair. The school is keen to replace this year if FoK could support, if we don't have sufficient funds it will be a request for next year

- Create an account you will be asked for your name, email address and to create a password.








#### Ways to help - Volunteering
