# Year 1 Home Learning 06.10.23


### This week in year 1 we have been:

Learning how to compare numbers using mathematical vocabulary 'greater than', 'less than' 'equal to'.

Writing speech bubbles for the characters from 'The 3 Little Pigs' story. Learning about different materials and their properties.

## **Home learning ideas:**

- Go to your local park or in your garden and look out for signs of autumn. Talk to an adult about what you notice or draw an autumn themed picture.
- Using recycled materials at home, can you make a house for the 3 little pigs?
- Have a go at comparing numbers using the 'greater than', 'less than', 'equal to' symbols. Can you compare these numbers by telling an adult what each symbol means?

### **Phonics:**

In Phonics this week we have been revising Phase 3 tricky words 'said', 'says', 'you', 'do', 'like', 'little', 'push', 'pull', 'put', 'full', and learning Phase 5 digraphs 'ay' ('play', 'day'), 'ou' ('cloud', 'sound'), 'oy' ('boy', 'toy'), 'ea' ('treat', 'each').
