## **Weekly Learning Letter**

### This week in Year 1:

## English:

In English this week, Year 1 have been writing a set of instructions for looking after their monsters. They used time adverbials first, next and then to order the instructions and took on the challenge of using bossy verbs that tell someone what to do.

## Phonics:

The children have been continuing their learning of alternative spellings of graphemes they already know. This week, we have introduced split vowel digraphs: e\_e (ee) even, ew (oo) stew, ie (ee) shield, aw (or) claw. Four new tricky words were introduced: house, mouse, water, want. Please do practise these new graphemes and tricky words at home using flashcards and games.

#### Maths:

In maths this week, the children have been learning their number bonds to 10 using part part whole models, cubes, counters and songs. They have also been using the part whole model to find missing parts of number bonds up to and within 10 using the counting on strategy and counters to help them.

#### Woodwork station:

The children have been really enjoying our new woodwork station! They have learnt how to use hammers and screwdrivers and have been busy fixing nails and screws to pieces of wood, always remembering to wear their goggles for protection!

#### Learning next week:

In English, Year 1 children will be introduced to the book 'The Castle the King Built' and will learn about the people that used to live and work in castles. They will think and talk about the role that they would take on if they lived in a castle and will do a piece of writing linked to this.


