This week in Year 2:



We learnt the Pantosaurus song and talked we talked about the rules for keeping children safe.

Maths / Number:

In Maths, we have been adding three 1-digit numbers. Our first step was to find the number bonds. We then added the remaining number. Draw number lines, or use your knowledge of number bonds, to find the answers.

3 + 8 + 7 = 5 + 4 + 6 = 14 + 8 + 6 = 17 + 4 + 3 = 26 + 5 + 4 =





English / History:

We have been practising using adjectives in noun phrases to add detail to our writing. How would you describe this picture? Which interesting adjectives could you use?

We also used conjunctions (and, but, if, so, or, when, because) to join ideas.

Which conjunction could you use to join these sentences about the picture?

- Red crosses were painted on the doors.
- The people inside had the plague.

Now write two of your own sentences **and** try joining them using a conjunction.

Phonics / Spellings:

We will be focusing on these words to help us with our writing:

- eye
- could
- should
- would
- who
- whole

Reading: Yes, and...

What happened next? Ask your child to keep the story going. Where do the characters go next? Who do they meet? Perhaps you can encourage your child to create their own new ending. They could bring in their work to share with their class.
