What an amazing end to another lovely week in Nursery. We are so very proud of all of the children and their wonderful performances on Thursday. They worked incredibly hard, in a short space of time, to remember the songs and the actions and they did both on the day with gusto. For many of the children, it was like being in a West End show, having to do it twice in one day!

When not singing, the children have been fully embracing our Christmas activities. They've continued to create decorations for the tree and even enjoyed decorating themselves! They have been carefully making Christmas cards, showing fantastic concentration, creativity and early writing skills.

Interestingly, we are noticing more and more children who are becoming increasingly drawn to mark making. These activities support children to further develop and strengthen their fine motor skills, essential for early writing. These activities also help children's focus and attention and provide a calming space for some quiet time or just to chat with their friends and the adults about everyday things. So, when you next see your child 'scribble', remember, this word has its roots in the Latin verb, *scribere* which means 'to write' and your child is probably doing some very
