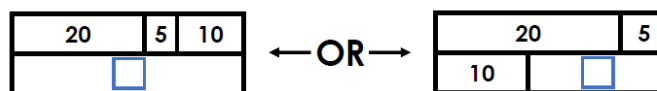
Maths / Number:
