This week in Reception:

Welcome back everyone, we hope you all had a lovely and restful break. The children have had a brilliant week and have settled straight back into the routines of the day. Phonics:

This week in phonics we have been reviewing the sounds taught during last term and have continued practicing blending sounds together to read words. The children have been enjoying practicing these through games such as 'pop it in the bin' and phonics noughts and crosses.

Maths / Number:

This week in number, each class has been focusing on a variety of mathematical skills. In Tigers and Lions, the children have been practising the formation of numbers from 1-10 and have also been learning about the number bonds to 5 and how these can be represented using part-part whole models and numicon. Bears have been practising creating, telling and recording their own number stories by adding different groups of objects together (such as different small world animals).
