Dulwich Picture Gallery

We enjoyed a wonderful trip to Dulwich Picture Gallery on Wednesday/Thursday. We took part in an art workshop where the children experimented with a range of artistic skills. They made rubbings, created observational drawings and painted using watercolours. A great day was had by all!

English

We started the week off by writing our holiday news. The children were excited to talk about what they had been doing during the holidays and we recapped using full stops and capital letters consistently in our writing. We also learnt about poetry and the children performed parts of a poem 'Hand on the bridge' by Micheal Rosen in front of the class. We talked about patterns and rhyme they noticed in the words of the poem and how we can use actions and create a beat to make a poem come to life.

Maths

We introduced measuring volume and capacity. The children explored these concepts and what they mean and completed some practical activities.

Science

The children learnt to name and label parts of the body. They drew around each other and wrote down as many parts of the body that they could. We played simon says with body parts and then the children wrote down body parts on post it notes and stuck them to the correct body parts on their friends!

PSHE

This week the children learnt about Jealousy. We watched a video and discussed a range of different situations where a child might be jealous and thought about what we could do to improve those situations.

PE

The children have taken part in multi skills this week. This week we focused on balancing and the children had to balance a range of different items on their heads and walk along a line. It was important they remembered to keep their head straight and arms out when balancing.

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Next week we will be:

English: Looking at the poem 'Queue for the zoo' and creating our own.

Maths: Multiplication and division- We will be exploring and making arrays.

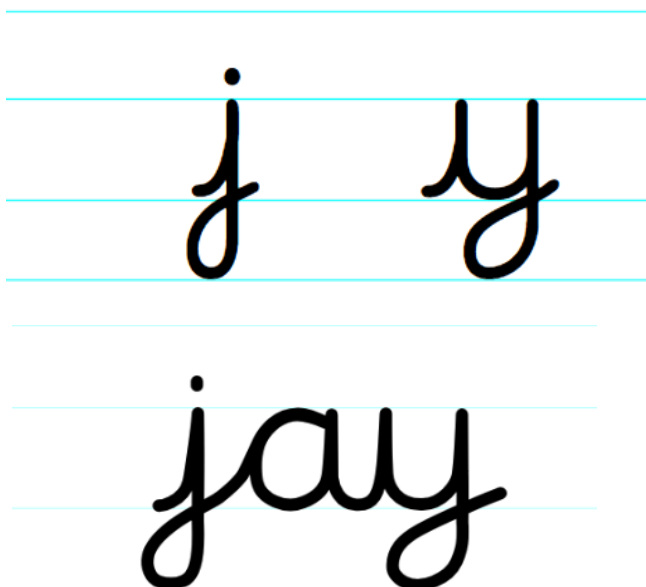
