This week in Year 2:

We started exploring rural Kenya and what life is like for the people living there. We thought about how life is different for a child living in rural Kenya compared to a child living in rural England.



We also learnt some facts about the Maasai Mara tribe of Kenya.

English:

In English we looked at the cover of our topic book and made predictions about the story just by looking at the illustration on the cover and the title. We also used what we already know to help us with our predictions. We shared ideas of what 'Lila and the Secret of Rain' might be about.



Then we read the story together and made inferences about how Lila feels at key points during the story. We selected appropriate words to describe these feelings.



In reading we are focussing on inference skills. This is about making a sensible guess about something you don't know for sure, based on the clues or information available. For example, by looking at a person's facial expression in a story and seeing that they are smiling, we can infer they are happy.

Science

Our Science topic this term is 'Uses of everyday materials' and this week we went for a material hunt around the school and identified the properties of the materials we found. Find an item at home that uses more than one material, draw the item and label each part with the material it is made of. Name some of the properties.
