This week in Nursery

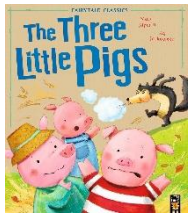

This week is all about the number 3 and as a result we have been enjoying 'The Three Little Pigs' story. Having now read the story, we will start to act it out over the next week, using handmade props including finger puppets and masks. The children have also been really engaged in doing puzzles, working in little teams to help each other fit the pieces together. Puzzles are great activities for pre-school children as it helps them strengthen their finger muscles as they hold the pieces, turning them and joining them together. It is brilliant for developing hand eye coordination and helps to build visual perception. This includes visual memory, seeing similarities and differences, recognising shapes and patterns and making sense of how they fit together.

As the weather remains chilly and rainy, we decided it was time to make a comfy winter vegetable soup. The children loved cutting the vegetables and then blending the soup together once cooked and dunking buttered bread when it was time to eat! What a great way to sneak those elusive vegetables into our mealtimes! The verdict – a bit like Marmite, you either love it or hate it!



Finally, the children have been very creative, using block paints to make pictures. They have been experimenting with different ways to paint, using their fingers and hands as well as the brushes! We even decided to have a go using toy cars! What do you like to use when painting?
