Thank you to all the parents who accompanied us on our visits to the Dulwich Picture Gallery. The children had a great time and enjoyed creating art in the gallery's studio.

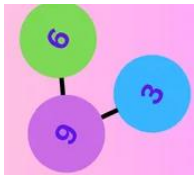
Our learning this week

Maths

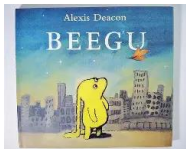
The children have been using the addition symbol (+) to show that parts can be combined to make the whole.

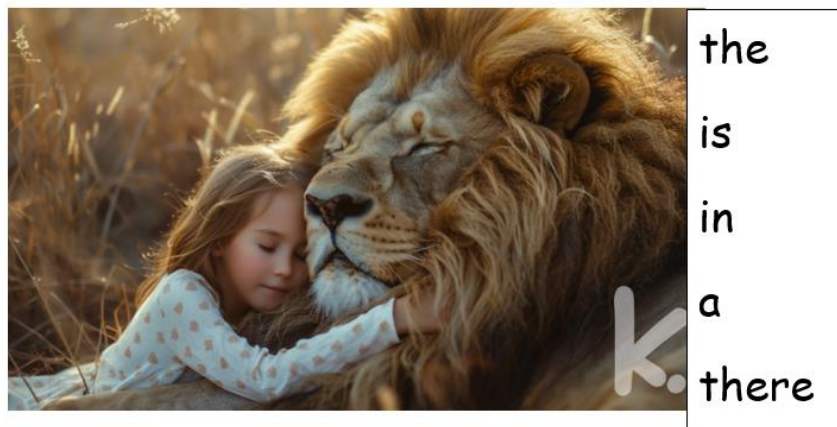
