**Our learning this week:**

**Maths**

We have been identifying odd and even numbers and finding patterns to help us to identify if a number is odd or even.

**When you are out and about, go on a number hunt. What numbers can you find? Is the number odd or even? How do you know?**

**(Odd numbers end in 1,3,5,7,9. Even numbers end in 0,2,4,6,8.)**

We have been doubling numbers up to 10. Practise these at home:

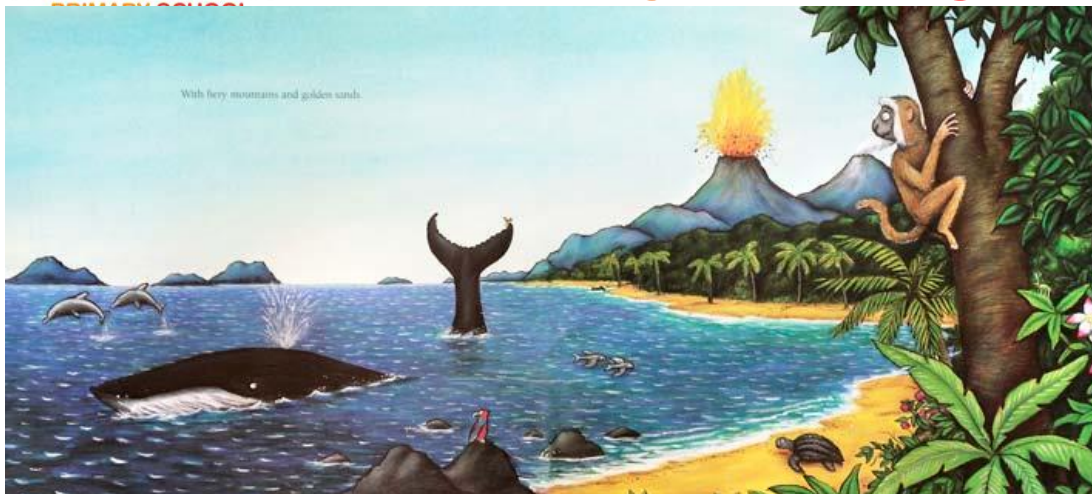
Double 1 = 2      Double 2 = 4      Double 3 = 6      Double 4 = 8  
Double 5 = 10      Double 6 = 12      Double 7 = 14      Double 8 = 16  
Double 9 = 18      Double 10 = 20

**English**

Our new book is 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson. We read the story and clarified any words and phrases that we were unsure of. We talked about our favourite part of the story and explained why we liked it. We used adjectives to describe the setting, e.g. the fiery volcano, and had a go at putting these into sentences. Look at the picture below. Pick an object in the picture, e.g. trees. How many adjectives can you think of to describe it?



**Science**

We have been finding out about our senses. This week we focused on our sense of taste, smell and sight. Did you know that our sense of smell helps us taste our food? Go on a sensory walk and focus on one sense at a time. What can you hear? What can you smell? What can you see? What can you touch?
