

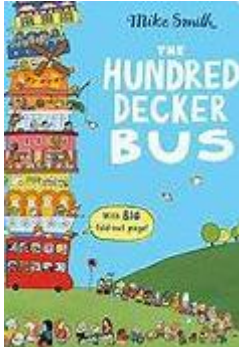


Weekly Learning Letter

Our learning this week:

English



This week in English, we introduced our new text 'The Hundred Decker Bus.' The children shared their favourite part of the story in learning partners and thought about which decks they would like to visit and why.

Maths

This week we have focused on time. The children have learnt the differences between the minute hand and the hour hand. As well as reading o'clock and half past. The children worked collaboratively to order our daily routine and match the correct time to each task.
