Phonics

We first reviewed Phase 3 graphemes and some Phase 2 Digraphs. Then continued with Phase 4 to practise reading CVCC, CCCVC and CCVC words such as; **printer, softest, splashes, boast**. The children have been reviewing and practising **all the** tricky words! At home you can support your child by reading with them frequently, any type of story time is beneficial whether it is an audio story, you reading to your child or your child reading to you.

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Maths

This week we have had a Maths mash up! We have revisited lots of different topics that we have covered over the year: counting, number bonds, capacity, length, addition, doubles, sharing and more!

At home, please continue to practise Maths through practical activities, such as baking (measuring) hanging up washing (counting in 2's) and water play (capacity)!
