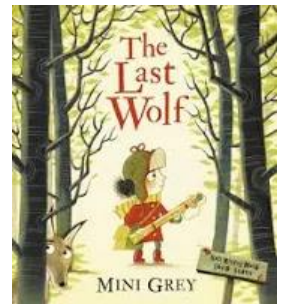


### This week...
