This week....

- We have been focusing on our DT project - designing and making wolf masks.
- We looked at masks from around the world and talked about why people use masks.
- We evaluated a range of shop bought masks. We thought about:
 - Who might use the masks?
 - What is the mask used for?
 - How does the mask work?
 - What choices has the designer made?
 - What is original about the mask's design?
 - Is the mask authentic?
- We designed a wolf mask which needed to include an attached nose, fixed ears, and a way for the user to secure it to their head.
- We reused card from boxes and packaging to make our masks.
- When we had finished making our masks we evaluated them and talked about what we would change if we made them again.
- In Maths we have been consolidating our learning from this half term.



Next half term, there will be some changes to our Indoor PE days:

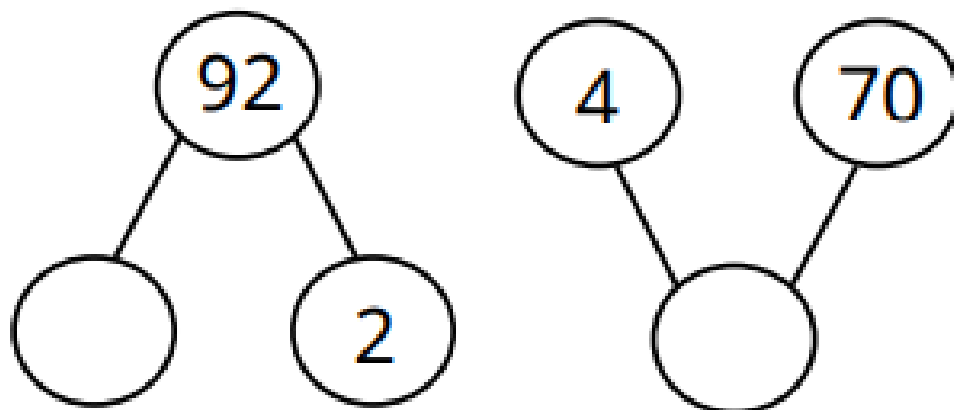
- Shona's Class will have dance on Wednesdays with Georgina.

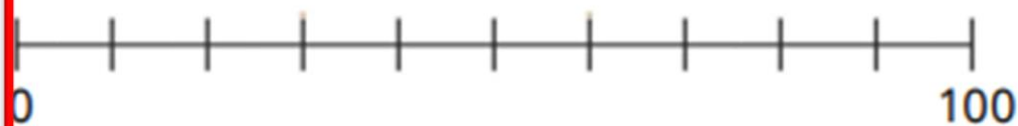
Complete the part-whole models.
