Year 1 Home Learning

18.9.26

We have had a very busy week in Year 1 and we even had a mystery to solve!

English

This week something strange happened in Ladybirds, Butterflies and Treefrogs. Straw, sticks and bricks appeared in the classrooms! After a full-scale investigation the children discovered that the Three Little Pigs had left them there. The children really enjoyed solving the mystery!

Maths

In Maths the children have practised:

Subitising - to subitise means instantly recognising the number of objects in a small group, without counting.

Conservation - recognising that if nothing has been added or taken away from a group, then the amount is the same.

Using **numerals** to represent number, understanding that a **numeral** is a symbol or name that stands for a number.

Using **ordinal numbers** to describe position, e.g. first, second, third, fourth, fifth

Science

We have been talking about seasons and how in the UK we have four seasons – spring, summer, autumn and winter. We have begun to talk about why we have different seasons and what happens in each of the seasons. Look out for changes in the local environment – can you find any signs of autumn?

PE

Our focus this half term is on gymnastics. The children have been practicing different shapes and composing their own sequences. They have also learnt how to do a straight jump and a star jump.

Reading

Your child has chosen a picture book to take home for the weekend. Please read it to them and talk about the pictures and the story. Encourage them to make predictions about what is going to happen next. Next week we will begin group reading.

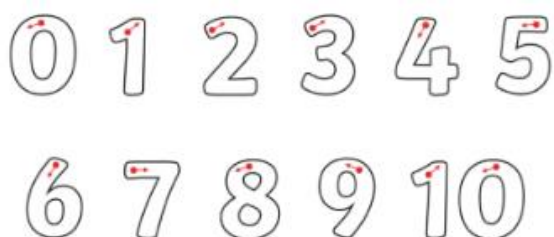
