**MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS** A reminder that we are required to have evidence (appointment card, letter, etc) to support your child's absence due to an appointment during school time. This includes visits to the doctor, dentist, optician, music exams or secondary school visits/tests. Parents will be asked for this if it is not provided.

**END OF DAY COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS** It is not always possible to deliver late collection messages received after 3pm. Please remember to call in advance.

**CONTACT INFORMATION** It is important that the school is provided with up to date contact information for parents, carers and emergency contacts. If you have changed phone numbers recently please ensure you inform the school office.

Similarly please ensure that we have a contact number for anyone that you have arranged to collect on your behalf.

**TEXT MESSAGES** Information being sent by text is usually sent to the first main contact in the family/household unless you have requested otherwise. We would expect parents to communicate this information to other members of the family as we are not able to send a text to everyone in a family or household.

**MUSIC INSTRUMENT LESSONS** You can now apply for musical instrument lessons online through our website. Unlike our enrichment clubs, instrumental lessons continue automatically each term unless you give notice to stop. You can apply at any time and will be added to a waiting list for the next available space.

**ENRICHMENT AND INSTRUMENT CLUBS** You will have received the clubs information sheet today – please check your child's bookbag. Application to re-apply for enrichment clubs is available on our website from today, Friday 9<sup>th</sup> December. You can download this or access it under the "Parents" drop down menu, then "Enrichment Clubs". Click the "Apply Now" link at the top of the page. Alternatively, there will be an application booklet at the office, where you can request a copy of the rules and tutor information if needed.

Applications for instrument lessons are also available on our website under the "Music" drop down.
