SCHOOL MEAL PRICE INCREASE The cost of primary school paid meal will be increasing from £2.00 to £2.10 per meal effective 1st May 2017. This increase is designed to reduce the subsidy schools provide for the provision of school meals. At £2.10 Lewisham meals continue to provide all of the Government nutritional requirements and compare favourably with other local authorities.

Older children are only allowed to go without an adult as a privilege and will only be allowed to attend independently if they behave appropriately. **We rely on donations to continue to provide this facility.**

MEDICINE IN SCHOOL Can parents please ensure that all medication, including epipens, are up to date and that children who require an asthma inhaler have one on them at all times.

If your child is no longer requiring medication already provided or no longer needs an asthma inhaler, please inform the school, in writing and arrange to collect the medication.

Medication administered during school time will require a medical form to be completed and is to be handed in at the office. Under no circumstances should children have medicines in their school bags.
