SAFETY NEWS

Another reminder for parents to review how their children are walking home, now that the nights are drawing in:

- Try not to walk alone – find a friend to walk with
- Do not walk down a lane or unlit road that isn't busy with traffic or pedestrians for a short cut. Take a longer route which is safer
- If approached by someone and feel unsafe start to run, yell loudly and head towards where there are people e.g. shops
- Safe places include shops, schools, libraries, restaurants, take away shops, stations, bus stops where people are waiting
- Speak to a known adult, if concerned about safety
- Do not walk around with headphones in and a phone on display.
- 999 is the number to call to reach the Police in an emergency
