

### Next Cake Sale: 28 March 2018 for Young Lewisham Project

The YLP was established in 1974 and over the last forty years has helped approximately 150 young people each year. It offers a wide range of supportive, alternative, vocational programmes to young people who do not succeed in mainstream education for a variety of reasons. Their main goal is to give young people opportunities to expand and grow, through education and training as well as assisting them into further education or employment and giving them the skills and abilities to live independent and useful lives.

Situated on Kilmorie Road, directly opposite Kilmorie Primary School, YLP has previously worked with our school, most recently making props for the Interactive Neverland activity at the Christmas Fair. Many Kilmorie families have participated in the charity's 'Born To Ride' programme over the past three years, learning how to successfully maintain their bikes and basic cycling skills together.
