DINNER MONEY The cost of meals for this half term (8th January-15th February) is £60.90. The amount for the full term (8th January to 5th April) is £123.90.

If your child is due to go on school journey in January, please deduct the sum of £10.50 from the total as appropriate.

A reminder if you wish to change the meal option for your child, it has to be for the entire half term.

All dinner money payments should be made on ParentPay. Please remember that school meals have to be paid in advance.

If you have any outstanding amounts, you will have received notification from school. We would appreciate prompt settlement of any monies owing.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS Please remember to renew/amend your free school meal eligibility for the Spring Term if this is due for renewal.

INSTRUMENTS All our instrument lessons and ensembles resumed this week. Please ensure that your child has their instrument with them on the correct day and takes it home at the end of the day. Many thanks.

ENRICHMENT CLUBS

Attendance - A reminder to, please, inform the office if your child is not going to attend their enrichment club on the day they are in school.

Outdoor Enrichment Clubs – Please ensure that your child is dressed in appropriate cold weather clothing and equipment (e.g. shin pads) if they attend one of our football, tennis or hockey clubs. Outdoor clubs will continue to run unless it is absolutely pouring with rain so children should have waterproof coats, and hats including gloves if it is cold.

SAFETY IN THE PLAYGROUND For safety reasons please can parents support the school by adhering to the following rules before and after school:

- When coming into or going out of school, the main gate **must** be shut firmly after you. This is particularly important at the end of the day when children are being collected from clubs. We all have a duty to keep our school safe.
- For the safety of your children, when accessing the school you are required to identify yourself or state the purpose of your visit at the gate before you are allowed to enter the school premises when collecting children from enrichment clubs or Wrap Around Care or at any other time during the school day.
- Some visitors tailgate a parent/visitor who has been officially admitted into school. Please could parents be cautious as to who is following them in and ensure that they are directed to the school reception.
- Children should not be riding scooters and bicycles in the playground
- The climbing frame in the main playground and equipment in the Year 1 playground is for use during school time only (**9am-3.30pm**).

Please help us to maintain safety in the playground and keep the children safe.

SCHOOL OFFICE The office is manned from 8am until 5pm. Please arrive promptly to collect your child at the end of the day:

- School finishes at 3.30pm
- Enrichment clubs which finish at 4.30pm with the exception of Y2 Football on Monday which finishes at 4.45pm
- Wrap Around Care which closes at 6.30pm.

Parents arriving after these times are likely to incur a late collection charge.
