REMINDER OF PICK UP AND END OF DAY ARRANGEMENTS

- Please inform the school office **and** the teacher (or vice versa) about any changes to end of day collection arrangements.
- It is not always possible to ensure everyone is informed promptly if play day messages are phoned through at 3.25pm when the office is already busy. Late notification also has an impact on club registers if the child(ren) concerned attend an after school activity club. Change of collection arrangements should be phoned through to the school office as early as possible and by no later than 2.45pm.
- The school office is manned from 8am until 5pm. Please arrive promptly to collect your child at the end of the day (3.30pm), from after school enrichment clubs that finish at 4.30pm or from Wrap Around Care which closes at 6.30pm. Parents/Carers arriving after these times are likely to incur a late collection charge.

AVOID THE ZIGZAGS A reminder that if you do drop off or collect your child by car, and you are in the habit of stopping or waiting on the zigzags, please be aware that this could lead to you receiving a Penalty Charge Notice. There is a mobile CCTV traffic enforcement vehicle in operation in this area.

It would benefit the whole school community if parents and carers could be considerate of this and not park on the zigzag lines and steer clear of the fire gate. These spaces are designed for emergency access and should be treated so **at all times**.
