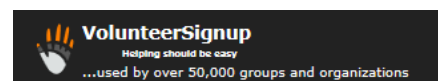


More Summer Barbecue Volunteers Wanted

- **Bottles** – we desperately need any sort of bottle (wine, shampoo, soft drinks, bubble bath, olive oil, condiments etc) for our bottle tombola. If we don't get more donations, the bottle tombola won't go ahead!
