AMENDMENT TO SPRING CLUBS DATE 2020 Please note that there is an error with the spring term dates sent previously, which had our clubs ending during the week ending 3rd April. They actually end during the week ending **FRIDAY 27th MARCH**.

Please also note the summer dates which begin on a FRIDAY and finish on a MONDAY, and have a Friday bank holiday and a Monday INSET!

HEALTH ADVICE At this time of the year there is often an onset of colds and infections, some of which are highly contagious, like the norovirus (sometimes known as the 'winter vomiting bug').

The symptoms of norovirus are very distinctive - if you suspect that your child is showing signs of the norovirus (a sudden onset of nausea followed by projectile vomiting and watery diarrhoea) please follow the advice below.

If your child has a bout of diarrhoea and/or vomiting (D&V) and to stop the spread of the virus, the Public Health Protection Team's advice is that you should allow 48 hours after the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea to ensure your child is clear of the bug. An infection is self-limiting and most people make a recovery in 1-2 days

It is also important to keep your child hydrated and to talk to them about hand washing using soap and water to promote good hygiene.
