**CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE** Following updated Government guidance the advice is if pupils or staff members develop symptoms, as listed below, they must **stay at home for seven days**.

This will help protect others in your community while you are infectious.

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are **recent** onset of:

- New continuous cough, and/or high temperature
- A high temperature above 37.8 degrees centigrade
- Shortness of breath

For most people, Coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild infection. If anyone became ill during the school day they will also be sent home and asked to remain at home to self-isolate for 7 days.

You do not need to call NHS 111 to go into self-isolation. If your symptoms worsen during self-isolation

Public Health England advise that if you are worried about your own, your child's or colleague's symptoms or the symptoms worsen or are no better after 7 days of self-isolation, contact **NHS 111 online** to seek further medical advice. If you have no internet access, call NHS 111. For a medical emergency dial 999. Do not go in person directly to your GP surgery or other healthcare environment.

At the moment we are cancelling trips where it is necessary to use public transport however we will keep you informed on this.

We will continue to prioritise handwashing and hygiene routines for all members of our school communities.



Next week is British Science Week and the theme is 'Our Diverse Planet'. Each class will be going on a 'Nature Walk' around the school grounds looking for signs of Spring as well as carrying out science activities and experiments throughout the week. Get involved by exploring the outdoors, whether it's your street, garden or local park. You could set a challenge, e.g. how many different flowers can you find?

**PLEA FOR SPARE CLOTHES** We are desperately in need of spare clothes! If you have any tops, bottoms, underwear age 5-8yrs (reception to year 2) which your children have outgrown or you no longer need, please could you consider donating them to the school. If you have any items which need to be returned then please bring these back.

**HEALTH ADVICE** A reminder if you suspect that your child is showing signs of the norovirus (a sudden onset of nausea followed by projectile vomiting and watery diarrhoea) please follow the advice below.

If your child has a bout of diarrhoea and/or vomiting (D&V) and to stop the spread of the virus, the Public Health Protection Team's advice is that you should allow **48hours** after the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea to ensure your child is clear of the bug. An infection is self-limiting and most people make a recovery in 1-2 days

It is also important to keep your child hydrated and to talk to them about hand washing using soap and water to promote good hygiene.

**MEDICINE IN SCHOOL** It is the parent's responsibility to ensure your child(ren) do not have medicines in their school bags. Medicines must be handed in at the office and a form completed.

**ATTENDANCE** If your child is unwell and this goes over 3 days, parents must call the school again every fourth day to provide an update.
