Dear Parent/Carer,

Reception and Year One are going to be using an online tool called Seesaw to set our home learning (should we go into lockdown). Seesaw is a secure online learning journal where teachers will upload suggested work and children can create and upload their work to document their learning. Your child will add things like photos, videos, documents, drawings and voice recording to their Seesaw journal. Seesaw journals are private and only accessible by the teacher, pupils and parents.

It is a requirement of Seesaw's terms and conditions that we gain parental permission to use their platform and we would like to do that now. Seesaw has a thoroughly robust privacy policy (<https://app.seesaw.me/about/privacy>) and has committed never to share your child's personal information or journal content.

In addition to protect the privacy of your child we will use individual class sign in for pupils instead of email and use their first names only.

I hope that your child will enjoy using Seesaw to document and share their home learning if we unfortunately have to go into lockdown again or our bubble is asked to isolate.
